Class Changes Effective January 1, 2022

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2022, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2022, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial

Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

Toys are allowed in the ring

Toys must be non-audible

Toys may not leave the handler's hand

Toys that roll freely cannot be used

Food/treats are not allowed in the ring

FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.

A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2022, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

PRIZES & AWARDS

- Rosettes will be given for first through fourth place in each jump height in each class.
- Green qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores.
- Rosettes will be given for new titles.
- Anyone achieving an AKC MACH or PACH at these trials will receive a rosette, bar and a certificate entitling him/her to \$40 off entries in a future SOTC agility trial.

Dogs must qualify to be eligible for all prizes. Unclaimed prizes will not be mailed.

ELIGIBILITY & CLASSES

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect their physical or mental performance, are not eligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

Standard Classes: Regular and Preferred, All levels **Jumpers with Weaves:** Regular and Preferred, All levels

T2B: Regular and Preferred

Fast: Regular and Preferred, All levels

Premier Standard and Premier Jumpers with Weaves

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION:

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without dogs, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors.

OBSTACLES:

Obstacles will conform to current requirements of the Agility Regulations.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Judges or VMO will measure any dogs that do not have valid height cards. Owners/ Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in the standard classes, the jumpers with weaves classes & T2B classes.

EXHIBITORS should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. New York State law requires that dogs aged four months and older be vaccinated against rabies.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS FOR ALL TRIALS:

- ♣ ENTRY FEES: First entry: \$25.00 / Second entry: \$20.00 / Third entry: \$15.00 / Fourth entry: \$12.00 / Fifth entry: \$10.00 of the same dog each day. Per Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2, recording fees are \$0.50 and Service Fees are \$3.00 for a dog's first entry. There is a \$3.50 service fee for each additional entry by a dog.
- MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO: SOTC (Syracuse Obedience Training Club, Inc.)
- ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.
- ANY ENTRY WITH INSUFFICIENT FUNDS will be considered an invalid entry.
- RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee and will be charged a \$25 bank fee.

- ☼ DELIVERIES MUST BE MADE BY A MULTI-STATE, MULTI-NATIONAL CARRIER, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO USPS, FEDEX AND UPS in the first 24 hours.
- ★ TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES or entries without full payment cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Agility entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules that appear on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- New Simplified Jump Height Card Process: Each agility dog is still required to have an Official Jump Height Card/valid yellow form or be measured prior to running in any class. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during the day of show check-in. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for an exhibitor to designate whether the dog has a valid jump height card. Please check the appropriate box so that the trial secretary knows whether to include your dog on the "dogs to be measured" list. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have the original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. If a measurement is required, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have the dog measured prior to running. (Regulations for Agility Trials, chapter 2, section 4)
- Owners or handlers entering dogs in the Trial do so at their own risk and thereby agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them, or by their dogs. They also agree to abide by the Rules of the American Kennel Club and these Regulations.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except in the ring or in the designated warm-up area. Dogs must be ready for judging, and owners or their agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs at ringside when required. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- REFUNDS: Requests for any refund must include the following required documentation:
 - 1. A copy of Veterinarian's note/certificate.
 - 2. A copy of the final confirmation of the dog for which a refund is requested.

Requests prior to the start of the trial can be scanned and sent via email to the trial secretary or via snail mail. Once the trial starts, documentation must be presented to the scoring table before the first run of the first day the dog is entered. Bitches in Season: Any bitches in season with a Veterinary certificate, will be awarded a refund, less \$2.50 processing fee per class. Please notify secretary prior to the start of the trial. Bitches in Season - will be allowed on the grounds but not in the building

- INJURED DOGS can get a 50% refund of entry fees. Required documentation must be supplied prior to the start of the trial. SICK DOGS can get a 50% refund of entry fees. Any dog diagnosed, prior to the first day of the trial with kennel cough, K9 influenza or any other contagious disease and any other dog domiciled at the same residence, even if they are not yet affected, will receive a 50% refund if requested. Required documentation must be supplied prior to the start of the trial.
- No entry should be sent which requires a delivery signature. Entries received prior to the opening date will be returned to sender.
- Exhibitors are responsible for any errors in making out their entry forms. No entry fees shall be refunded in event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the trial closes.
- Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as possible by the secretary if you include an email address or stamped self-addressed envelope.
- All move-ups will be acknowledged by the secretary via email. If you do not receive confirmation of your move-up, assume it has not been received and contact the trial secretary as soon as possible. No move-ups will be accepted after 6:00 pm on the Monday, prior to the show.

USE THIS FORM TO MOVE UP TO A HIGHER AGILITY CLASS ONLY

It is the option of the club to allow day-to-day move-ups. Exhibitors should refer to a club's premium list to verify the club's policy for moving a dog up. If offered, dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of the dog qualifying for an agility title.

The request for moving up must be made to the Trial Secretary according to the club's published policy. All move-up entries are subject to availability of the class and payment of any difference in entry fee. Dogs so moved-up will be entered at the end of the running order. Refer to Chapter 1, Section 20 of the Regulations for Agility Trials for additional move-up requirements.
