She works with multiple breeds of dogs.

Classes

Saturday morning, June 22, 9 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Young Dogs: For dogs who are learning to heel on leash, sit, stay, down on cue. All exercises will be done on leash. Start the path toward smooth, precise, animated heeling, including figure 8, footwork, and cues. Troubleshoot your training fronts, finishes, fast recalls, stand for examination.

Saturday afternoon, June 22, 1:30 p.m. to 5 p.m. Heeling: For dogs competing at Novice and above. Focus on attention work and handling distractions. Individualized attention on how the handler works the dog. A look at typical problems and ways to solve them. All heeling.

Sunday morning, June 23, 9 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Ring Ready for Open Classes: Dogs should be closing in on or competing in Open classes and able to work off leash. Let's put on the polish. Where are you weak and how do you work to fix that? Sequencing exercises.

Sunday afternoon, June 23, 1:30 p.m. to 5 p.m. Ring Ready for Utility: These dogs are closing in on or competing at Utility. Let's put on the polish. Where are you weak and how do you work to fix that? We will perfect the skills you're struggling with.

Pricing: Saturday classes have 10 working spots. Sunday is limited to 8 working spots. Unlimited auditing (auditing can be paid on the day of the class). SOTC members at \$150 for a working spot and \$50 to audit a class. Non-members are \$180 for a working spot and \$80 to audit a class.

Registration opens April 10 for SOTC members. Registration opens May 1 for non-members.

There will be **no refunds for working spots after June 1**, unless your spot can be filled. Registration will be done in the order the forms are received. We will maintain a waitlist. Snacks and water will be available, but if you are staying all day, please bring your own lunch. Limited crating is available in the SOTC building, but please bring a comfortable chair.
